David Frederick Dodds, 21, of Route 3 died Sunday as the result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

Walla Walla. He played in the Prospect Point and Garrison Junior High bands. He sang in the Wa-Hi choir and played on the junior varsity baseball team for Wa-Hi.

Dodds was a musician and performer at the Jazz and Coke Coffee House, and played for the entire season with the Trails West performances at Fort Walla Walla Park Amphitheatre.

He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.

He is survived by his parents, at home; three sisters, Sharry Dodds of Bellevue, Donna Dodds of Seattle and Judy Dodds of Eugene; a brother, Timothy Dodds of Walla Walla; and his grandmother, Belle Kent of Seattle.
